Percussion students may be assigned to any of our three bands; however, students will be assigned to only one co-curricular schedule. G3 percussionists will follow the Wind Ensemble or Symphonic Band schedule and G4 percussionists will follow the Concert Band schedule. Band assignments will be determined by the Percussion Director.

REHEARSAL CONFLICTS – Student’s Responsibility – Read Carefully

“Request for Excused Absence Form” is available in the Band room and on the Band’s web page at www.lnband.com. Please complete all information on the form & give to the director 2 weeks or more before conflict date.

***In Season Athletes are in most cases excused from band practice as needed – Communicate before a season begins with your director!**

Extra/Co-Curricular Participation Conflicts - If a student participates in more than one school activity, **it is the student’s responsibility to compare both schedules carefully**. The music and athletic department have agreed that students will split overlapping practice time between the two activities when practices conflict, however, if many conflicts exist, the student should not participate in both activities during the same season i.e. football & marching band. **The band program will “go the extra mile” in trying to work with our band athletes while they are “in season” with athletic teams to be sure they are able to participate fully in our performing groups.** Please inform us when you have concerns. When conflicts are not excessive, it is the student’s responsibility to inform both parties as early as possible. Performance conflicts will be resolved by adhering to Lawrence North High School’s Extra-curricular Conflict Policy. This policy is printed in the LNHS student handbook.

Please use a **“Request for Excused Absence Form”** well in advance of absence (10 day minimum). **Parent signature required.** Directors will determine if the absence is excused, excused with make-up, or unexcused.
